Beckford's Tower is a unique venue of literary, historical and architectural interest, offering intimate ceremonies for 2-40 guests.

Choose from the rich, eclectic surroundings of the main museum room, the dramatic backdrop of the loggia above the front steps, or (for up to 4 guests) the breath-taking views from the Belvedere at its summit.

The iconic pink 127-step spiral staircase is a magical background for photographs, as is the atmospheric Victorian cemetery with its arches and gates.

Beckford was a passionate, romantic, scandalous and eccentric man famed for his exquisite taste.
